Player Code of Behaviour

"Our aim is to ensure that all players behave according to the "Wolfpack Way" at all times and for players from other clubs aspire to be like us both on and off the court"

All Wanneroo Basketball Association (WBA) Players are required to carefully read and adhere to this 'Code of Behaviour' immediately:

- a) Always compete in a hard, but fair manner at all times.**
- b) Never argue with an Official during a game. If you disagree, ask your Coach or Manager approach the official during a break or after the game.
- c) Control your temper. Verbal abuse of Officials, sledging other players, and deliberately distracting or taunting an opponent is not acceptable behaviour and will NOT be tolerated by the WBA. Technical fouls will incur a penalty.
- d) Work equally hard for yourself and your team. You will benefit, and so will everyone involved with your team.
- e) Be a good sport. Appreciate all good plays, whether made by your team or the opposition.
- f) Understand that your Coach is the main point of focus for instruction when at training or in matches and will be listened to with proper attentiveness. Without them there would be no team.
- g) Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants, regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religious beliefs.

Joondalup Wolves Representative Players:

- h) All WBA Representative Players must train with their Domestic Club team. Training for all players is compulsory and any absences must be duly advised to the coach and/or team manager with plenty of notice. Should there be any training time conflicts between WABL and Domestic teams, please refer to point 2 below.
- i) In the event that a player breaks team rules (eg such as missing training without notice, not follow the coach's instructions etc), understand that the Coach has the discretion to take disciplinary action that may include not playing a player, limiting a player's court-time or other action deemed appropriate.

AGREEMENT...

'As a condition of entry to participate in Wanneroo Basketball Association Inc. events, programs or competitions, I agree to abide by the Player Code of Behaviour as outlined above.

I understand that breaches of the above conditions may be referred either directly to my relevant club, to an appointed Management Committee or to a full tribunal, who at their discretion, can impose penalties up to and including the immediate removal of the player from Wanneroo Basketball Association events, programs or competitions entirely.

For more serious breaches, the Games Manager on duty has the authority to immediately request the removal of the player from the Wanneroo Basketball Association venue and refer the matter to the Tribunal for further action.

Joondalup Wolves Representative Players:

- 1) *All Joondalup Wolves Representative Players must compete for a Club in the WBA Domestic Competition (unless prior approval granted by the WABL Sub Committee). This rule applies to Representative Players competing between U/12 and U/18.*
- 2) *Should any training time conflicts arise between WABL and Domestic teams, the Joondalup Wolves strongly encourage players and their families to resolve these issues with the coaches of each team, so that a suitable outcome for all is achieved.*

Should this not be possible, then the position of the Joondalup Wolves is that players MUST attend WABL training at a minimum of 2 out of every 3 scheduled sessions.
